- Communications has been explicitly moved to be a part of the Training work stream
- The aim is to encourage and equip those working on the RSO (including academics) to speak with confidence and pride about their work and its impact
- A dedicated training session is included in the RSO conference agenda consisting of:
 - A summary of how the media has changed and how it operates
 - A summary of how the nuclear industry communicates with examples of good practice



- Three online training sessions run during the year for researchers (around 15 participants in all). Focus was public engagement - with a Dragons' Den format for pitching ideas.
- Around 10 SMEs also attended training on Communicating Controversial Topics
- Potential for researchers to attend NWS community engagement events during this coming year, if appropriate events occur.
